WHEREAS

There are currently 20 staff members and 300 trainees enrolled in the year 2022-23 through 7 different trades offered (1 year 4 tades & 2 year 3 trades). The key trades are Electrician, Fitter, Welder, ICTSM, Fashion Technology, Sewing Technology, and Plumber etc.

SECOND PARTY will offer training in the filed of Robotics & Internet of Things (IoT), with the help of Godrej Enterprises Group's initiative.

c. Termination:

Either party, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice, may terminate the MoU in whole, or in part, at any time before the date of expiration without liability tothe other party. Further, either party may terminate this MoU, if the other party is in breach of this MoU and fails to cure such breach within ten (10) days after written notice to that effect. Not withstanding such termination equipment mentioned, infrastructure provided in compliance with clause No. 6 and or as per the terms and conditions of this MoU by the SECOND PARTY" shall rest in the FIRST PARTY.

Except as otherwise provided herein, neither party shall use any trademark. Service mark.Logo or other proprietary right of the other party without that party's consent. THEFIRST PARTY shall not publish or otherwise disseminate, in any form or format, any information arising out of orrelated to this MoU without SECOND PARTY'sprior written review and approval. THE SECOND PARTY shall not be entitledto publish or otherwise disseminate information, in any form or format throughany media platform, about the Purpose using FIRST PARTY's name, without prior written permission of the FIRST PARTY

h. Intellectual Property:

Except for the permitted use of Confidential Information, each partyacknow-ledges that, under this MoU, a party neither acquires any intellectual orother property" including but not limited to copyright, trademark, business or tradesecrets, methodologies, professional techniques, works of authorship, training material, courseware or content ("IP") from the other party nor any right in IPfrom the other party.

i. Anti-Corruption Laws :

In conformity with the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act or any rules or regulationsthereunder, with all similar international laws, and with SECOND PARTY relevant corporate policies, FIRST PARTY shall not take any action which would cause it to be in violation of such anti-corruption laws, including but not limited to (i) the use of any funds for unlawful contributions, gifts, entertainment, or otherexpenses relating to political activity or (ii) making or attempting to make, offering or authorizing any unlawful payment, thing of value, bribe. Each party shall be responsible for its officers, employees, agents, contractors or students (if applicable) intentional or negligent acts or omissions and howsoever caused, to the extent allowed by applicable law.

1. Modification:

Modification to this MoU shall be made by mutual consent of the parties throughthe issuance of a written modification, signed and dated by authorized representatives of each party, prior to any changes being performed.

m. Dispute:

All disputes, controversies or differences which may arise between the partieshereto out of or in relation to or in connection with or interpretations of this MoUor for the breach thereof shall be settled amicably between the parties through negotiations and shall not be referred to any' Tribunal/ Arbitrator or court of law.
